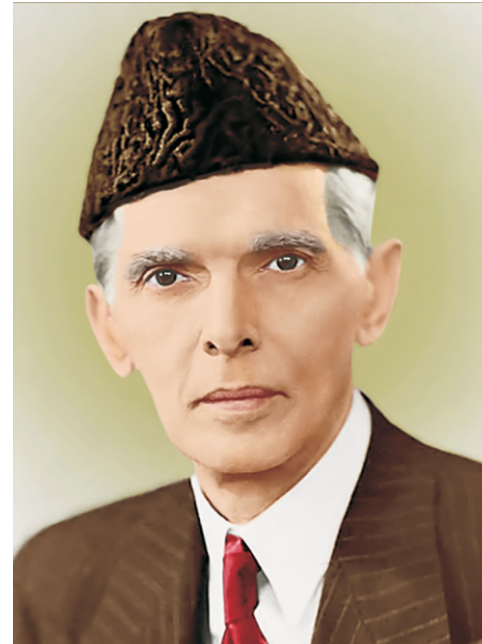

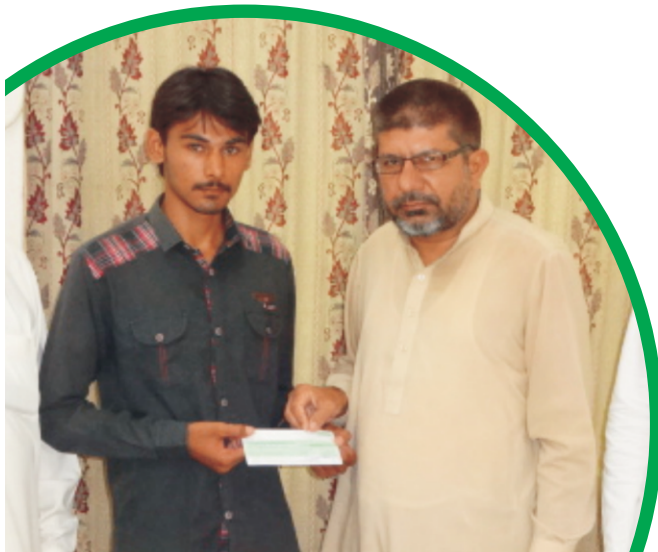

## College Library

Fully air conditioned library of G.C.T. Bhawalpur plays a vital role in providing upto-date information and help to stay abreast of ever changing times. This library was established in 1962. The library has the capacity to house nearly 100 readers at a time. It holds an extensive collection of over 17,000 books. It remains opened six days a week through out the year from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Computers are available with internet connection. The whole record of the library is computerized. Numerous up-to-date journals and publications cater to almost every need of teachers and students.



## Library Rules

- 1- A student must have college Library Card.
2. Library card is non-transferable. In case of any damage of card, student may get a new by paying Rs. 5/-. If card is lost, he can get a new one by payment of Rs. 25/-.
- 3- The student has to pay 10% more cost and original amount of book if issued book is torn, over marked or any other kind of damage.
- 4- Books are issued only for 14 days. In case of non-return of book within due time, six rupees per day will be fined.
- 5- Only two books will be issued at a time.
- 6- First come first get the book in case of shortage of books.
- 7- Reference books will not be issued but can be study in the library.
- 8- Re-issuance of the same book is allowed.
- 9- If a book is lost, buy new book and return to library with 10% fine. If book is not available in market, student will have to pay double price of the book lost.
- 10- Rental book is issued for the session. If book is not returned at the end of the year, one rupee fine will be imposed every day.
- 11- Students of third year will return the books before 1st annual examination of PBTE.
- 12- The student whose issued book is lost, will not be allowed to get any other book unless he pays fine or return the book.
- 13- After issuance of book, student should check the book thoroughly, otherwise he will be responsible in case of any damage.
- 14- Study place is available for students within the library, where they can study books, journals, newspapers etc. In case of loss of any kind, student will be held responsible for.

- 8- Immoral action, drinking and other addictive items are not allowed in the hostel. Accused students will be expelled and will also suffer punishment declared by the college council. Immoral action, drinking, Smoking and other addictive
- 9- Electric heater/iron is not allowed, violation may result in fine or expulsion from hostel.
- 10- Principal/hostel administration may check the students at any time for any reason without any prior information.
- 11- Show of weapons/arms in hostel may result in expulsion from hostel.
- 12- Any kind of political or sectarian literature and preaching is strictly prohibited.

After the expiry of the date fixed by Punjab Board of Technical Education Lahore for admission of reserved seats (Reciprocal, FATA, AJK, Northern Areas, Armed forces, childrens of employees of TEVTA and the qualified students of Govt. Technical Training Institute/Centers etc). The principal is fully competent to convert the remaining vacant reserved seats on open merit.

The above-mentioned number and division of seats may be changed/alterd without assigning any reason at any time with the orders of the respective authority. The Candidate of Bahawalpur Division is also eligible to get admission on the prescribed seats on all Punjab Basis. But for this purpose he will have to apply separately.

Human Rights Minorities Department will pay Fee/Funds for the minorities, as applicable at the time of admission with reference to TEVTA/GM(O)/Minor/79/1430 dated 3rd June, 2010.

## Admission System

### Eligibility:

The candidate who wants to get admission must have the following eligibility,

- (A)- He must be pass in Matric (SSC) from any Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education or equivalent to Matric (SSC) having subjects Elective Maths, English, Physics and Chemistry.
- (B)- His aggregate marks should be at least 40% in Matric (SSC) exams.
- (1)- The Candidate who is failed in any subject mentioned above or he has passed his Secondary School Certificate in "E Grade" will not be eligible for admission.
- (2)- Such candidates who have passed any one of the above mentioned subjects in "Grace / Concessional Marks", and these marks are included in the aggregate marks, will be considered eligible for admission subject to that they may fulfill the rest of conditions for the admission.



- (3)- Preliminary admission will be on provisional basis and it will be confirmed after the verification of Matric Result Card/Certificate from the respective Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education. If any candidate succeeded to get admission by producing bogus result card/certificate, his admission will be cancelled immediately without assigning any reason and his case will be referred to the POLICE.
- (4)- The candidate who has learnt the Holy Quran by heart will be awarded 20 additional marks. The Hafiz-e-Quran will have to provide documentary proof/certificate for Hifz and he will have to appear before the admission committee for the test and verification that he has learned the complete Holy Quran by heart.
- (5)- Student who have passed GTTI one year certificate with Matric (Science) will get 20 additional marks.
- (6)- Student having passed his Matric (Science) exam with industrial subject will also get 20 additional marks, if he has 60% marks in industrial subject.
- (7)- Age relaxation upto 1-years will be granted by the principal.

### Physical Fitness:

The candidate should be physically and mentally fit for admission.

### Age Limit:

The age of candidate should be within 18 years on 1st September, the year in which he is seeking admission, however candidates having age more than 18 years can get Age Relaxation from Concerned authority. (Principal can relax age up to 1 year for the applicants of open merit. Principal can relax age of Disable, TTI/TTC and Hafiz applicants up to three years). After displaying the merit lists, the application for the age relaxation will not be considered.

### NOTE: (Change of Shift)

- (i) Age Limit for second shift (evening) is 28 years.
- ii) Students admitted in second shift (eve.) will not be allowed to change the shift at any cost.

## Important Instructions

- 1- Admission dues will be deposited at the time of interview. No further time will be given and next applicant on merit will be entertained.
- 2- Bring original documents at the time of interview.
- 3- Interview schedule is in prospectus. No further information will be delivered.
- 4- If any applicant does not claim additional 20 marks of Hifz-e-Quran / Industrial subject in merit, he himself will be responsible for this negligence.
